So grab your pencils and pens! Here's what you need to do ...

Key Stage 1 (school years Reception, 1 and 2) applicants must draw a picture of the home of a story tale character and write about the person who lives there.

Key Stage 2 (school years 3-6) applicants must choose a fictional character from a book you have read and write a detailed description of the home in which you imagine they live, as well as its setting. You may draw a plan to accompany your writing.

11-16 year-olds in approximately 300 words, write a short story. The last sentence must be "There's no place like home."

Once you have created your picture or story send your clearly named entry with the slip below to Chorleywood Bookshop (4 New Parade, Chorleywood, Herts WD3 5NJ).

The closing date for entries is Friday 13th March. There will be first and second prize winners in each category and winning entries will be published on our website. First prize is a trophy, £15 bookshop voucher and certificate, and second prize is a £10 bookshop voucher and certificate. We apologise that entries cannot be returned.
